

Berkshire Lodging Options

At Camp Unleashed at Camp Becket there are two options:

1) Private rustic cabin

The rustic are grouped in little "villages" of about 8 cabins in a circle and each village has their own centralized modern Group Wash House which is heated and lit 24/7 (so it can be easily found in the dark). The wash house has hot running water (regular showers) and regular flush toilets. Each shower and toilet has an individual stall, and the wash houses even have private outdoor showers. Yes, the dogs are free to go in with you.

The cabins are very comfortable but have no electricity. Each normally houses ten people – eight children in the main room (4 bunk beds), one counselor in a side room and one in a vestibule area, so there are essential private rooms (one with a door) for two people. The cabins offer more privacy and more of a nature setting.

2) Room in Gibson Hall

The other option is to stay in Gibson Hall, which is a two story historic lodge type building with electricity. The Ground Floor has 5 large rooms with a large double story open atrium space in the middle. On the Ground Floor there are two separate, individual bathrooms (one with a shower).

The Second Floor (reachable by stairs) has 7 large rooms with 3 to 4 bunk beds each all lined up around the outside. On the Second Floor there are two shared Group Wash Rooms. It is similar to a school dormitory setting in that each of the rooms.

Please note that Gibson Hall is at one end of the camp so it's a slightly longer walk (1/4 mile or approx. 5 city blocks) to and from the main waterfront, Dining Hall and activity areas.

The cost is the same whether you choose a rustic cabin or room in Gibson Hall.

Private single, Private Double, or Shared

In either of the two cases, you can choose to have the cabin or room all to yourself and your dog (private), or share with 1 person (private double) or share with up to 2 more people (shared). The rates vary depending on the number of people in a cabin. (\$899 for a private single, \$899 per person for a private double and \$799 per person for shared. If you want the less expensive double or shared accommodation and aren't coming with anyone, we can match you up with an appropriate cabin-mate based on the info we have about you and your dog. (Of course, if it doesn't work out when you get to camp, we can adjust accordingly).

After you've attended your first session, there are a few more options to choose from including 8 really large, newly constructed cabins in Iroquois Village (still no electricity) but very spacious and new and two "suites" in Gibson Hall (for doubles or more) with their own private bathroom in the rooms.



Since we take reservations at each session for subsequent sessions, these are generally all already reserved by alumni. However, if you are willing to share, there is always a chance that you could be matched up with someone who has already reserved these special accommodations.
